

Key Themes:

- Visits were determined based on the number of students that did not have ESL information reported in Aspen SIS
- Ensuring that ESL certified staff are fully leveraged at the school
- Hiring qualified staff and non-renewing provisional staff that are not qualified
- Review of folders for EL students with Disabilities to ensure IEPs are translated and signed
- DOJ/OCR is focusing on the District's ability to self monitor that services are provided




Correct ESL Instruction Type

% of ELs with the Appropriate ESL Instruction Type




Requisite Weekly ESL Minutes
