Mission Areas are comprised of the capabilities required for achieving the function at any time (before, during, or after an incident) and across all threats and hazards.

Mission Areas differ from phases of emergency management. Each mission area consists of the capabilities required for achieving the mission or function at any time (before, during, or after an incident) and across all threats and hazards. It is important to shift your thinking to capabilities rather than phases.

5 Mission Areas:

Prevention: The capabilities necessary to <u>avoid</u>, <u>prevent</u>, <u>or stop a threat</u>. It is focused on ensuring we are optimally prepared to prevent an imminent terrorist attack within the United States. As defined by PPD-8, the term "prevention" refers to <u>preventing imminent threats</u>.

Protection: The capabilities necessary to <u>secure the homeland against acts of terrorism and human-caused or natural disasters.</u>

Mitigation: The capabilities necessary to <u>reduce loss of life and property by lessening</u> <u>the potential impact of disasters</u>.

Response: The capabilities necessary to <u>save lives</u>, <u>protect property and the</u> environment, and meet basic human needs immediately after an incident has occurred.

Recovery: The capabilities necessary to <u>assist communities affected by an incident to recover effectively</u>.

Three of the core capabilities are common to all five Mission Areas: Planning, Public Information and Warning, and Operational Coordination.

These capabilities:

- Unify the Mission Areas.
- Are necessary, in many ways, for building the other capabilities
