What is ESSER?



- Allowable uses are very flexible: "preventing, preparing for, and responding to COVID-19"
 Addressing learning loss
 Preparing schools for reopening
 Projects to improve school air quality
 Coordinating preparedness/response
 Purchasing technology
 Mental health services and supports

- 20% of ESSER for Recovery
 addressing learning loss through evidence-based interventions
 - (summer learning, extended day/year, or after-school programs)
 Must address the disproportionate impact of COVID-19 on underrepresented student subgroups


